<b>Organization</b>	<b>Grant Amount</b>	<b>Purpose</b>
Kids Discovery Museum	\$2,500	To fund a science, mentoring program that benefits local elementary students who participate in the science projects as well as high school students who mentor the younger students.
BI Arts & Humanities Council	\$2,300	To purchase multi-media equipment including an LCD projector, a lap top computer, and PowerPoint software for use by local nonprofits.
Interfaith Volunteer Caregivers	\$1,500	To purchase a computer that will enable more efficient and timely matching of volunteers with requests for assistance.
Island Music Guild	\$1,600	To complete construction of a sound studio that requires special sound-proofing, enabling teens to practice and rehearse with drums and other percussion instruments. (A DAF is providing funding for construction of 3 sound studios.)
BI Parks Foundation	\$2,500	To fund restoration of the Battle Point Transmitter building's original historic front doors, and fund an ADA bathroom.
One Call For All	\$7,750	To redesign their website and database interface, thus enabling more accurate tracking of donations, and allowing donations to be made online in a more efficient manner.
