<b>Organization</b>	<b>Grant Amount</b>	<b>Purpose</b>
Kids Discovery Museum	\$2,600	To help fund the free passes to the Museum that are distributed through libraries and social services.
Helpline	\$4,400	To pay for the new floor at Helpline's food bank as part of the recent remodel to address structural deficiencies and create an open floor plan that encourages self-service.
Interfaith Volunteer Caregivers	\$1,500	To help support personnel costs with increased staff hours and rent due to a 27% increase in services in 2005 and more expected in 2006.
Martha & Mary Lutheran Services	\$1,500	To expand Martha & Mary's horticultural program for seniors through the development of a greenhouse.
BI Parks Foundation – Yeomalt Cabin Restoration	\$1,000	To help support the restoration of the cabin for public uses including performances, readings, out-door education, celebrations, classes and community gatherings.
BITV	\$2,500	To help purchase a live streaming server that would allow all BI residents to view video from island nonprofit organizations.
Housing Resources Board	\$3,500	To help finance the software recommended by their accountant as vital in effectively managing HRB's low-income properties.
Bainbridge Island Public Schools Trust	\$2,000	To fund the reading and academic remediation program in the Bainbridge Island public schools.
Sound Works Job Center	\$1,000	To help cover the costs of operating Sound Works Job Center, enabling it to provide a wide spectrum of employment support resources and services to the unemployed of North Kitsap County.
