- Your nominating letter, limited to 500 words or less, should include an overview of why your nominee deserves this award and include information that supports the selection criteria listed below.
- Two pieces of support materials, such as newspaper articles, resume, etc., may be attached to the nominating letter.
- Please include contact information, including telephone number and email address for both the nominee and the person submitting the nomination.
- **The nominating letter and support materials must be received by email, to birkenfeldaward@bainbridgecommunityfoundation.org or by hard copy at the Bainbridge Community Foundation office by 5 PM, Friday, July 23, 2010.**
- Nominators will receive acknowledgement of their letter and support materials no later than July 31, 2010.
- Presentation will be at the Bainbridge Community Foundation's annual Philanthropy Celebration Awards Ceremony on October 16, 2010.

Selection Criteria for the 2010 C. Keith Birkenfeld Humanitarian Award

- *Unpaid community volunteer.*
- *Minimum five years volunteer service .*
- *Demonstrated contribution to addressing a serious community need.*
- *Demonstrated leadership, inspiration and dedication while addressing a serious community need(s).*
- *Service on nonprofit board(s) or committee(s).*
- *Demonstrated a positive impact on those served and/ or the nonprofit organization(s) delivering such services.*
- *Contribution is clearly well beyond the normal call of duty.*
